Clarkson Covered Bridge Photographers Guidelines

We love the fact that you have chosen our park and facilities to use as your backdrop for your photographs. It has been brought to our attention that some photographers are not heeding the rules and are not helping to maintain the beauty of the park. Please follow these guidelines, failure to do so can result in banning the use of our facilities for your photography business.

- No sidewalk chalk or graffiti of any kind.
- No vehicles allowed on the covered bridge, the only motorized vehicles allowed are those used for maintenance by county employees or motorized wheel chairs. This includes but is not limited to motorcycles, scooters, golf carts, tractors, lawnmowers, ATV's, cars, or trucks.
- No nudity or partial nudity.
- If you bring it, you clean it. This is for all props; please if you are using artificial flowers or anything that is not naturally decomposed make sure you clean it up.
- Respect the caretaker's home and privacy. No one should be on his porches or behind his/her home.
- Beside the waterwheel is a bridge that has stairs at the end beside a flowerbed, use this
 as your boundary the walk leads to the left, this walkway, and landing can be used, but
 please do not continue up around the home.
- Please be aware that this is a county park, and that there will be wildlife we cannot control.
