Clarkson Covered Bridge Visitor Guidelines

We love the fact that you have chosen to visit our park and facilities. It has been brought to our attention that some patrons are not heeding the rules and are not helping to maintain the beauty of the park. Please follow these guidelines, failure to comply with these guidelines can result in your being banned from our park or serving jail time.

- No sidewalk chalk or graffiti of any kind is allowed. This includes, but is not limited to; Writing on the buildings, bridge, bathroom stalls or walls, porch railings, stairs, doors, door/window jambs, benches, tables, swings, or sidewalks.
- No vehicles allowed on the covered bridge, the only motorized vehicles allowed are those used for maintenance by county employees or motorized wheel chairs. This includes but is not limited to motorcycles, scooters, golf carts, tractors, lawnmowers, ATV's, cars, or trucks.
- No nudity or partial nudity.
- If you bring it, you clean it: please if you are using artificial flowers (for weddings or receptions) or anything that is not naturally decomposed make sure you clean it up.
- Respect the caretaker's home and privacy. No one should be on his/her porches or behind his/her home.
- Beside the waterwheel is a bridge that has stairs at the end beside a flowerbed, use this as your boundary the walk leads to the left, this walkway, and landing can be used, but please do not continue up around the home.
- Swimming in Crooked Creek is solely "At Your Own Risk."
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed.
