

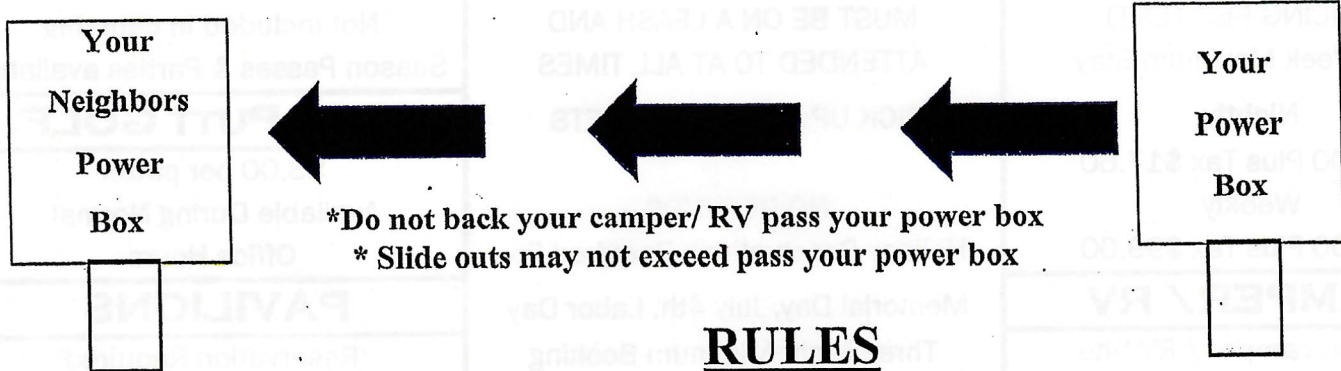
About Your Campsite

ALL SITES ARE BACK IN

Look for your campsite number on the power box.

Facing the power box, your campsite is to the left of your power box, but ends at the next power box or the road, whichever one comes first.

Please do not infringe on your neighbor or you will be asked to move. Camp within your space.



- No pallets or lumber or plywood for camper (only true firewood)
- No appliances of any kind outside of campers on campsites (small refrigerators included)
- No old batteries, pressure washers, old propane bottles, etc.
- No outside trash cans (dumpsters are provided by the Park)
- No furniture outside of campers (such as recliners, couches, end tables, coffee tables, etc.) outside lawn furniture only
- No utility/lawn mower trailers left at your site
- No dog houses and pets must be on leash and attended to at all times
- No clothes line
- No ATV off road vehicles and no dirt bikes
- No swimming pools
- No fireworks
- No outside storage container of any kind
- No cutting of trees or shrubs / damaging any live shrub is prohibited
- No parking on vacant campsite / guest will be required to park in overflow area
- Recreation items such as horse shoes, corn hole, etc. must be removed when not camping
- No outdoor furniture is to be left out when campsite is not occupied
- One picnic table per campsite. Do not move any from other sites
